Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 50% online entries (165 runs) and 50% paper entries (165 runs). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

TRIAL INFORMATION

The show site will be available to exhibitors on Friday after 6:00 p.m. The building will be locked nightly at 7:30 pm. The ring sizes are 99' x 100' for Standard and 90' x 100' for JWW classes on packed dirt. The facility is enclosed with no A/C but fans if needed. There is concrete flooring to crate on. Please stack crates whenever possible. Crates may be left overnight at your own risk. **No dogs shall be left in the building over night.** On-site concessions will be available with breakfast and lunch.

Move-Ups

Move-ups for Saturday, October 10, 2009 **will be accepted prior to 6:00 pm on Monday, October 5, 2009** by email at lotuskiffe@att.net or by snail mail. Move ups on Saturday will be made on forms provided at the trial site not later than 30 minutes after the completion of the trial. Move-ups from Novice A to Novice B are NOT allowed during a trial weekend.

AWARDS

Rosettes will be offered by the Australian Cattle Dog Club of America for First through Fourth placements in all classes, as well as for dogs completing MACH or PAX titles. A decorated pole will also be offered to any dog completing a MACH or PAX title. All first place winners will be able to select a prize from a designated toys/treats container. Awards will only be given to dogs who have earned qualifying scores. A plush "Tulsa" Australian Cattle Dog Douglas Cuddletoy will be given to each Australian Cattle Dog entered in these trials.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS (Please read !)

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request whether or not they have sent a copy of such with their entry. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog measured by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. **For express check in, please send a copy of your height card to the trial secretary with your entry. We are no longer allowed to keep height cards on file. A new copy must be sent with each entry whether or not you've sent it to this secretary before.**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP), Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), or an Approved FSS Breed are eligible to participate except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are allowed to participate.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- I.** The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- II.** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- III.** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- IV.** No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- V.** Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; **illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. IF THE ENTRY FORM IS PHOTOCOPIED, THE AGREEMENT ON THE BACK OF THE FORM MUST ALSO BE PHOTOCOPIED AND ATTACHED TO THE ENTRY WHEN IT IS MAILED. Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted or entries which specify any conditions as to its acceptance.**
- VI.** No refunds for duplicate entries. However, care will be taken to find duplicates before processing. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.
- VII.** Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry and will have a \$25.00 service charge attached.
- VIII. Entry fees for bitches coming into season shall be partially refunded.** ACDCA will refund an exhibitor for bitches that came in season after the closing date for the entire daily entry fee minus ten dollars. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim by 6 p.m. the day before the trial.
- IX.** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- X.** AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG CLUB OF AMERICA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any recourse or claim against AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG CLUB OF AMERICA or any official thereof.

The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
